TITLE:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 13-6(D) OF THE WHEAT RIDGE CODE OF LAWS CONCERNING PENALTY ASSESSMENT FINES FOR EXCESS VEHICLE WEIGHT VIOLATIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Wheat Ridge (the "City"), acting through its City Council (the "Council"), has authority to enact ordinances for the protection of public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, exercising this authority, the Council has previously enacted Chapter 13 of the Wheat Ridge Code of Laws (the "Code") concerning the regulation of motor vehicles and traffic upon roadways within the City; and

WHEREAS, Section 13-6(d) of said Chapter 13 sets forth a fine schedule that applies to penalty assessments issued for violating City laws concerning maximum wheel and axle loads and maximum gross vehicle weight; and

WHEREAS, the state of Colorado has established a similar fine schedule for violations of the same offenses under state law; and

WHEREAS, the state has updated its fine schedule to generally increase the amounts of penalty assessments and several other jurisdictions neighboring the City have updated their respective fine schedules to mirror the state's fine schedule; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that it is desirable and in the City's best interest to impose penalties for vehicle weight violations that are uniform with those imposed by the state and neighboring communities for the same offenses.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEAT RIDGE, COLORADO:

- **Section 1.** Subsection 13-6(d) of the Wheat Ridge Code of Laws, concerning penalty assessments issued for violations of maximum vehicle weight restrictions, is hereby amended as follows:
 - (d). Excess weight—Penalty assessment. Any person who pleads guilty or is convicted of violating the weight limitations of either section 507 or section 508 of the Model Traffic Code, as amended, shall be subject to the penalties of subsection (b) of this section and for each axle and/or gross weight violation an additional penalty assessment fine according to the following schedule:

Section 2. Safety Clause. The City Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that this Ordinance is promulgated under the general police power of the City of Wheat Ridge, that it is promulgated for the health, safety, and welfare of the public and that this Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of health and safety and for the protection of public convenience and welfare. The City Council further determines that the Ordinance bears a rational relation to the proper legislative object sought to be attained.

<u>Section 3. Severability: Conflicting Ordinances Repealed.</u> If any section, subsection or clause of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, the validity of the remaining sections, subsections and clauses shall not be affected thereby. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 4. Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after final publication, as provided by Section 5.11 of the Charter.
