



Survey Methodology

- 8th time conducting the Wheat Ridge Resident Survey
 - Previous iterations in 2004, 2006, 2008, 2012, 2015, 2018, and 2021.
- Survey conducted from March 7th to April 18th, 2023
- Sampling approach employed:
 - Multi-contact approach (postcard + two survey "waves")
 - Probability-based, mail-based sample of 4,500 households
 - 844 total responses received
 - 19% overall response rate
- Results statistically weighted to reflect Wheat Ridge
- 95% confidence interval with a +/- 3% margin of error









Community Characteristics Ratings, 2021-2023




Transportation in Wheat Ridge is a potential area for improvement.

Sales Tax Funding for Transportation Projects



- > Filling sidewalk gaps throughout the city with an emphasis on major pedestrian corridor














Feelings of Safety in Wheat Ridge, 2021-2023

Please rate how safe you feel in the following areas in Wheat Ridge:



Importance of Police Department Resource Prioritization


How important, if at all, is it for the Wheat Ridge Police Department to prioritize resources in each of the following areas in the next 12 months?



Percent essential or very important


Police Department Priorities by Year




